Fexofenadine (Allegra)	seasonal	Hypersensitivity to fexofenadine	2 years and older	Occasional headache	age 12 and older, 60mg b.i.d or 180mg q.d. age 2 to 11, 30 mg b.i.d.	OTC
Loratadine (Claritin, Alavert)	both	Hypersensitivity to loratadine or desloratadine	2 years and older	Possible sedation with higher than usual doses	age 6 and older, 10 mg q.d. age 2 to 5, 5mg q.d.	OTC
Desloratadine (Clarinex)	both	Hypersensitivity to desloratadine or loratadine	6 months and older	Possible sedation with higher than usual doses	age 12 and older, 5mg q.d. age 6 to 11, 2.5 mg q.d. age 2 to 5, 1.25 mg q.d.	Prescription
