- Submit a 300-word post-meeting summary on your experience

- Join Dr. Eisenberg and other recipients at a dinner on Sunday during the meeting
- Participate in meeting with legislators on Capitol Hill on Monday following the meeting
- Participate in a local meeting/event with their Member(s) of Congress
- Recipients are invited to attend a reception sponsored by the ENT PAC (the AAO-HNS political action committee), separate fee may be required
