

## AAO31: Otitis Media with Effusion (OME): Avoidance of Inappropriate Use of Medications

**High Priority:** Yes; Appropriate Use **NQF Number:** N/A

Percentage of patients age 2 months through 12 years with a diagnosis of otitis media with effusion who were not prescribed or recommended the use of steroids (either oral or intranasal), antimicrobials, antihistamines, or decongestants as therapy.

#### **Denominator:**

Patients aged 2 months through 12 years with a diagnosis of otitis media with effusion. \*OME is defined as the presence of fluid in the middle ear without signs or symptoms of acute ear infections.

None

## **Denominator Exceptions:**

Medical reason for prescribing/recommending medications.

#### Numerator:

Patients who were NOT prescribed or recommended to receive any of the following: antihistamines, decongestants, systemic corticosteroids, topical intranasal corticosteroids, systemic antimicrobials.
