Dear ABOHNS Continuing Certification (MOC) Exam Candidate,

The American Board of Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery understands the impact the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic is currently having on a local and global scale, especially in the lives of our diplomates. We are also unsure how long the pandemic will last. We want to help alleviate as much pressure as we can from you during this difficult and stressful time. As such, the Board has decided to postpone the Continuing Certification (MOC) Examination scheduled on May 6, 2020 to a date later this year, which is still being determined.

What does this mean for you?

- If you have already scheduled your exam appointment with Pearson VUE, your appointment will be cancelled for you, and you will receive an exam cancellation email.
- For those whose certificates expire this June, your certificate will be extended through December 31, 2020. This will cover the time for rescheduling exam administration and the release of results.
- You will be notified as soon as a new exam date is determined.
