

## AAO24: Allergic Rhinitis: Avoidance of Leukotriene Inhibitors

High Priority Status: Yes; Appropriate Use

NQF Number: N/A

Percentage of patients age 2 years and older with allergic rhinitis who do not receive leukotriene inhibitors.

#### Denominator:

All patients age 2 years and older with a diagnosis of allergic rhinitis who do not have an active order (prescription or reported over-the-counter use) of intranasal corticosteroids or second generation antihistamines.

#### **Denominator Exclusions:**

Exclude patients with concomitant diagnosis of asthma or sleep apnea.

### **Denominator Exceptions:**

Patients with allergy to intranasal corticosteroids, allergy to second generation antihistamines, or prostate issues (due to concern for intolerance of primary therapy options).

#### Numerator:

Patients who do NOT receive leukotriene inhibitors.

None
